<u>July's Preschool focus:</u>

Using the golden rules and talking about the importance of following them within the nursery day. Support children with fastenings using the boards in the pre-school room and changing skills, developing independence further in changing, dressing, and toileting skills and getting ready for school.

Some ideas to do at home:

- Listening out for emergency vehicles when on walks.
- Role play and dressing up at home.
- Talking about road safety when approaching crossings and the importance of looking both ways and waiting for cars.
- Talking about different occupations within the family.
- When brushing our teeth, talking about the importance of looking after them and the dentist.
- Talking about fire safety and what to do if there's a fire.
- Explaining the importance of water safety and being careful with water.
