July's Preschool focus:

More in depth look at the people who help us, why and how. Show an interest in different occupations. Plan and introduce new vocabulary related to the occupation and encourage children to use it in their speech and play.

Some ideas to do at home:

- Provide opportunities for children to explore the community and people around us. Look at who carries out roles and responsibilities in the environments you visit such as a shop assistant, green grocer, pharmacist, doctor, lollipop person, police warden, fire fighter, plumber or electrician.
- Visit different parts of the local community, including areas where some children may be very knowledgeable, e.g. Chinese supermarket, local church, elders lunch club, Greek café
- Create opportunities for children to log their experiences and memories through books, memorabilia, souvenir or through photos.
- Share stories reflecting peoples roles or professions
- Take your children to your work place and explore what you do, why and how.
- Talk to children about and practice fire, water and road safety
