For World Elephant day, we had a great time re-enacting elephants and playing a ring toss game with our trunks.

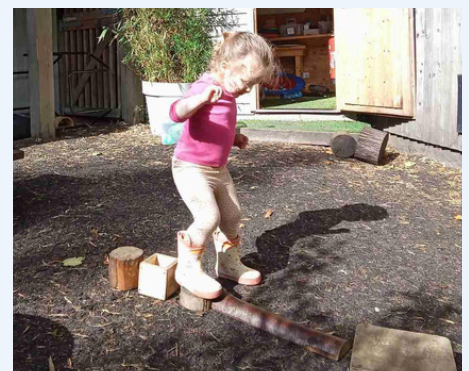
What's happening next month...
